

DIY EASTER BUNNY WREATH

With Chicken Wire

What You'll Need:


- Protective Gloves
- Plier
- Wire Cutter
- Glue Gun
- Chicken Wire
- Tying Wire
- Bunny Wreath Frame
- Artificial Flowers
- Artificial Leaves
- Other Decor

1 Prepare your supplies




Prepare your supplies. If you cannot find a bunny-shaped wreath frame, you can use two wreath frames and tensioning wire to form the ears.

2 Measure the chicken wire




Roll out your chicken wire and place your wreath frames on top of it, in order to determine how much you will need.

3 Cut the chicken wire



Cut around the shapes using wire cutters. Leave approximately 2 centimetres extra on the sides.

4 Prepare the shapes



Once you cut out your shapes, discard the excess chicken wire. Place your cut-out chicken wire under the shapes.

5 Wrap the edges



Once you cut out your shapes, discard the excess chicken wire. Place your cut-out chicken wire under the shapes.

6 Finish wrapping



Once you finish with the wrapping, your shapes should look like this.

7 Attach the two parts




Tie the two shapes together, using a piece of tying wire.

8 Paint the chicken wire




Paint the bunny wreath white, using spray paint. Put it aside, allowing it to dry.

9 Attach leaves



Wrap the artificial leaves around the sides of the wreath, securing the ends with your glue gun.

10 Attach flowers and decor



Add a bow to the neck of the bunny and decorate with artificial flowers, easter eggs or other decorations to your taste.

11 Enjoy your finished wreath!
