

# DIY CHICKEN WIRE FALL WREATH

## STEP BY STEP GUIDE

### What You'll Need:


- 3mm MDF sheet
- Chicken wire (40\*40 cm piece)
- Cutting tool (hacksaw)
- Decorations of your choice (e.g. fake leaves)
- Wire
- White acrylic paint
- Hot glue gun
- Pliers

### Step 1



Prepare your supplies. Select the decorations of your choice for your wreath.

### Step 2



Take the MDF sheet and draw a pumpkin on it with a pencil.

### Step 3



With a hacksaw or a sharp tool, cut out the shape of the pumpkin you drew.

### Step 4



Paint the shape with acrylic paint. We used white paint, but you can use any color you prefer.

### Step 5



Take the chicken wire and cut out the shape of the pumpkin with pliers.

### Step 6



With a hot glue gun secure the chicken wire to the base of the wreath in a few points.

### Step 7



Cut out pieces of wire which will be added to the edges of the wreath and to the inner lines of the pumpkin.

### Step 8



Wrap the pieces of wire with jute twine for a rustic look and secure the ends with a hot glue gun.

### Step 9



Glue the wrapped wires in place. You don't need to cover the top of the pumpkin as it's going to be decorated.

### Step 10



Take your decorations and arrange them on your wreath. Secure the ornaments with a hot glue gun.

### Step 11



Fold a piece of wire and wrap it with twine. This will act as a stem. Attach it to the back of the pumpkin.

### Step 12



Your pumpkin shaped fall wreath is ready for use! Hang it on a door or place it on a shelf.
