

HOW TO CUT a Fence Panel

What You'll Need:

- Protective gloves
- Wire mesh panels
- Tape measure
- Marker
- Wire cutters or Bolt cutters
- Sandpaper

1 Measure & Mark



Lay your mesh sheet on a flat, level surface.

Measure it accurately, and double-check your measurements before trimming.

Use markers to clearly indicate the cutting lines on the surface of your fence panel.

2 Choose the Right Tool



Selecting the appropriate tool primarily depends on the diameter of the wire you need when cutting fence panels.

For wires up to 2.5mm (12g), use wire cutters.

For mesh sheets with a thickness of 3mm (10g) or more, use bolt cutters.

3A Wire Cutters (max 2.5mm)



Trim each wire strand individually using a wire cutter, positioning the cuts as close to the weld points as possible.

Bolt Cutters (3mm +) 3B



In the process of how to cut a fence panel, the strongest wires can be shortened using a bolt cutter.

4 Final Adjustments



If the trim is uneven or rough, refine it with sandpaper or a metal file.
